Thank you for your communication applying for a stand space. Charity stands will be £30 for a 4 metre frontage x 6 metre depth, with a further charge of £6 per additional metre frontage. Due to changes, all charity requests need to be covered with a letter from Area/Head Office stating the names of the people who will be manning the stall. These people also need to have proper ID badges with them for entry on the day, otherwise, **ENTRY WILL BE REFUSED.** A letter after the event stating the total amount raised would also be appreciated.

Please complete the attached application slip and return your remittance in **FULL** for your stand requirements by **FRIDAY 8th JULY 2011** at the latest. Before the event you will be issued with your Trader's Pass that should be displayed on the front of your vehicle windscreen. This Pass should be **DISPLAYED AT ALL TIMES** on your vehicle. Your Pass entitles you to entry for a driver plus **ONE** assistant only. Numbers of helpers need to be stated on the form below. All stands are to be erected and manned by 10.30 am on Games Day. There will be a passageway of 1 metre to the left of each stand to allow for access to your van/vehicle etc.

Montrose Highland Games Committee accepts no responsibility whatsoever for any loss, damage or injury, however caused, to any persons manning stalls or to any structure, goods or equipment belonging to the stall holder. All stall holders are to ensure that they have the appropriate public liability insurance. **(Copy to be sent with acceptance slip and remittance)** Failure to send this insurance will result in **NO ENTRY** to the Games.

Fairground equipment may require to be inspected by the Local Authority. No live animals are to be awarded as prizes. All traders/stall holders must declare in advance the full nature of their proposed activities. If changes are to be made, contact and agreement must be made prior to the day of the Games or this could lead to entry not being permitted!

I look forward to receiving your signed application. If, for some reason, you are not successful in obtaining a stand space, your remittance and documents will be returned to you. Thank you for your interest in, and support of, Montrose Highland Games.

However, in order to prevent several identical or similar types of stalls/entertainments, allocation will be provided on a “First Come, First Served” basis, so early applications are strongly advised. Before the event you will be issued with your ‘Trader’s Pass’ that should be displayed on the front of your vehicle windscreen. This Pass should be DISPLAYED AT ALL TIMES on your vehicle. Your Pass entitles you to entry for the driver plus ONE assistant only. Numbers of helpers need to be stated on the form below. All stands are to be erected and manned by 10.30am on Games Day. There will be a passageway of 1 metre to the left of each stand to allow for access to your van/vehicle etc.
